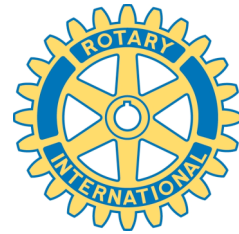


BEVERLY ROTARY CLUB FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS



The Beverly Rotary Club Foundation will be awarding to deserving Beverly residents scholarships totaling approximately \$20,000, with individual awards ranging in size from \$1,000 to \$5,000. To be considered, applications must be postmarked no later than April 16, 2010.

The scholarships are given to assist local students in meeting the expenses associated with furthering their education. Scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors and preparatory school students who will be enrolling as full-time students in a four-year or two-year degree granting program. The following criteria will be applied in selecting scholarship awardees:

1. Scholarships will be awarded to students whose parent(s) or legal guardian(s) reside in Beverly, Massachusetts.
2. Academic achievement will be an important consideration in the evaluation of candidates.
3. The financial needs of each student will be reviewed and will be an important consideration in the choice of scholarship recipients. Therefore, all applicants are required to submit a copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) portion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The information to be considered will include gross family income, debt, equity, etc. Extenuating financial considerations or hardships should be explained.
4. The experience of the student in extra-curricular activities and in providing community service will also be an important consideration.
5. Children of Rotarians are **not** eligible to receive awards.
6. Finalists for an award will be interviewed by members of the Scholarship Committee of the Beverly Rotary Club. The interview is an essential part of the decision-making process.

Completed applications and three (3) letters of recommendation must be postmarked by the **April 16 deadline** to:

The Beverly Rotary Club Foundation will interview selected finalists on May 18, 2010 and will make the final determination of students to be awarded scholarships after the interview and review of the candidates' past academic activities, extra-curricular activities, demonstrated financial need, and letters of recommendation.
